Weekly Events

Birdies:

All Birdies are reported by each player to the birdie chair. At the end of the season, money will be awarded based on the total number of birdies for the entire season. This is included in our annual dues.

Ringers:

The lowest score on every hole is recorded for each player each week. Tuesday handicaps will be used. A sheet is posted in the ladies' locker room with the low gross and net scores. Money will be awarded at the end of the season. This is included in our annual dues.

Paying the Pig:

Traditionally, when you land in a bunker, you donate a quarter which is collected after the round in a piggy bank. All contributions to the pig are donated to LPGA Girls Golf of Tucson at the end of the season.

Hole in One Insurance:

To be eligible for Hole in One insurance, you must be a member of Forty Niner WGA. The initial \$6.00 is to be paid to the treasurer. The money collected will be held in the Forty Niner WGA account. A list is maintained by the treasurer and shared with the 49er staff when a hole in one is made. The Hole in One may be on any day but must be at Forty Niner Golf Course and must be witnessed. When someone makes a Hole in One, those participating in the fund will be notified by email. Each participant will have two weeks to collect her drink. Drinks will be billed to the account of the member making the Hole in One. He member, who had the Hole in One, is only obligated to pay for drinks of those members who have contributed to the insurance fund. Forty Niner treasurer will issue a check to the member making the Hole in One for the amount being held in escrow. After members are notified by email of a Hole in One, another \$6.00 will be

expected to be paid promptly to rebuild the funk. Members will not be enrolled until they have paid the \$6.00.

Chip Insurance:

This is an optional event. Each week a dollar is collected in the pro shop. Place your dollar in the provided envelope and put your name on the front of the envelope. At the end of the round, anyone who has had a chip in, splits the amount collected. If no one has a chip in, the money is held over to the next week.
